Job Summary

Walmart Logistics is looking for a Custodian to ensure the assigned facility is maintained in a healthy, safe, sanitary way and in a timely manner. The Custodian will carry out routine building cleaning, regularly scheduled maintenance and will follow inspection procedures to ensure cleaning and custodial work is completed on a daily basis in accordance with established standards and deadlines that support our HACCP certification requirements. The Custodian will follow WHMIS safety standards and Workplace Health & Safety policies, practices and procedures and escalate any custodial, maintenance and/or safety issues to the Maintenance Manager.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities

- Safely and correctly performs facility upkeep activities (e.g. cleaning, maintain internal areas of the facility, operate sweeper/scrubber) and follows these requirements when doing work in a timely an effective manner.
- Spots unsafe working conditions, poor products, and improper services procedures in the facility, and reports them to management with ideas for how to fix the problem
- Ensures the facility upkeep equipment is in proper working order and supplies are organized and stocked
- Mixes chemicals used for equipment and cleaning, in accordance with WHMIS requirements and follows safety practices when dealing with chemicals and hazardous products
- Shows care and concern when serving associates/customers, asks questions in order to understand associate needs. Uses policies and information in order to exceed expectations. Finds and uses the right resources (people, products, tools) at the right time in order to resolve requests
- Uses policies, procedures, and/or guidelines to make good choices. Uses data and facts in order to make day-to-day decisions and involves others as needed. Recognizes a problem and informs those who can correct it
- Accepts responsibility and meets expectations for own work. Identifies steps needed in order to carry out work as required
- Listens to others and asks questions to learn about what is needed. Communicates the right information to associates and leaders when they need it. Communicates in a respectful and professional manner

- Makes sure work is done correctly. Works on top priorities first. Makes a consistent effort to get results. Meets deadlines. Takes action in order to solve problems so work can be completed in a timely manner.
- Follows company policies and procedures, shows integrity and ethical behavior in all work situations.
- Adapts to changing work demands, and changes to work assignments, shifts and locations.
- Follows regularly scheduled deep cleaning, maintenance and prepares reports as required under the HACCP program

Position Requirements

- Previous industrial cleaning experience is an asset
- Ability to operate cleaning equipment
- Knowledge of WHMIS, specifically related to MSDS and the safe use of hazardous materials in an asset
- Experience working in a HACCP certified environment would be an asset
- Must possess a strong attention to detail in order to thoroughly clean the facility
- Ability to work independently or as part of a team, with minimal supervision
- Good oral and written communication skills

Working Environment

- There is a requirement to work with substances that require special handling
- May work in areas requiring exposure to varying temperatures, extreme heat or cold, and/or wet, damp, or drafty conditions
- May be required to move over sloping, uneven or slippery surfaces
- May be required to work at heights, through narrow, enclosed or elevated spaces
- Requires physical activities that are necessary to perform essential functions of this position including moving up and down ladders and stairs. Manipulating equipment, objects of varying size and weight, requiring fine motor skills hand-eye coordination.
- Requires reaching overhead and below the knees, including bending, twisting, pulling and stooping.
- Moves lifts, carries and places merchandise and supplies weighing up to 50 pounds.
- Wearing personal protective equipment (PPE) as required, walking and standing for extended periods.
- Writing documents, reports etc.
